I) THE READINGS

- Are the discussions creatively participatory and is there a good balance between clinical material and the readings?

II) THE PHYSICAL SETTING

- Are personal or administrative disruptions an issue?
- Are there any issues regarding the use of speaker phones or videoconferencing? Or, are there any other physical/environmental issues?
- Do distance learners have the cellphone number(s) of a classmate or the instructor(s) to use if videoconferencing fails?

III) CLASS ATMOSPHERE

- Is confidentiality guaranteed?
- Has the absence policy been reviewed? Are there issues with tardiness?"
