- 1. Scot called meeting to order at 7:30. New members, Kelly and Taryn were welcomed.
- 2. Review September minutes. MOTION to approve passed.
- 3. Syllabus reviews. The committee discussed each syllabus at length. Overall, positive feedback on all. Cara will provide the following feedback to instructors.
 - a. Child clinical applications. Needs intentional readings and titles inclusive of diversity and intersectionality, bibliography specific to potential topics, organize topics and CA presenters at first class.
 - b. Self-Psychology. Recommendations to reduce reading load.
 - c. Early middle phase. Good as is.
 - d. Development of PsyA thought. Clarify learning objectives.
 - e. HD Latency. Needs active verb learning objectives, titles and brief descriptions for each class, readings attending to diversity.
- 4. 2020 2021 Teaching assignments
 - a. Year 1, Spring Ethics. Brainstorm ideas for instructors.
 - b. Year 1, Spring New course title: Intersectionality, social context and the co creation of clinical experience. Kelly Shanks and Kathy Weissbourd. This course will run first, ethics will run second.
- 5. 2021-2022 planning discussions will begin next meeting.
 - a. Piyale asked to teach Aging in Winter rather than Fall. That can likely be accommodated.
 - b. Letter of interest for teaching will go out in January. Zan and Scot will make it by electronic survey format with a specific request that ALL faculty fill out and return. Additional items to check would be: No interest in teaching; Willing to teach anything; Willing to co-teach but don't want full responsibility for creating syllabus; No interest in teaching a full course, but willing to be substitute.
- 6. Kelly will take on course evaluations task for this committee.
- 7. Scot clarified LOA policy at CAAO with positive feedback.
